Crochet pattern by **AradiyaToys**

1. Instruments and materials

- 1.00 mm hook
- Light green, sand, milky white, brown, light pink yarn
- Black glass or safety eyes Ø 6 mm
- Sewing needle
- Stuffing material



Cow Mia is a design toy, created specially for “AradiyaToys Design” collection.

This toy was crocheted with “Iris” yarn. This is 100% cotton, 150m/25g. To create a toy with a height of 9 cm, you must crochet with single yarn, using a 1.00 mm hook. The stuffing material used in this toy is polyester wadding.

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2. Abbreviations

Ch	chain
Sc	single crochet
HDC	half double crochet
Dc	double crochet
Sl	slip stitch
INC	increase
INVDEC	invisible decrease
Sc spike	single crochet spike
BLO	back loops only
FLO	front loops only

Tip 2

To keep track of the beginning of the row, use a marker. Pin marker to the last loop of the row. Every new row must be finished with a loop at the marker.

Tip 1

The toy must be crocheted with tight stitches, to be sure that there won't be any holes through which stuffing material can be seen.

All amigurumi toys are crocheted with tight stitches. Avoid small holes when stretching crochet fabric, if there are some tiny holes, use a smaller size hook. To avoid seams, all details are crocheted in a spiral without slip stitch and lifting loops. There is a chance that you will lose the beginning of the row; to avoid this, use a marker. It can be a colored pin or thread of contrasting color.

3. Head

With light pink yarn

Ch12

- 1 row** Sc in second stitch, 9Sc, 3Sc in the next stitch (crochet round), 9Sc, 2Sc in the next stitch (that already has the very first single crochet) (24)
- 2 row** INC, 9Sc, 3INC, 9Sc, 2INC (30)
- 3 row** 1Sc, INC, 9Sc, (1Sc, INC) repeat 3 times, 9Sc, (1Sc, INC) repeat 2 times (36)
- 4 row** 2Sc, INC, 9Sc, (2Sc, INC) repeat 3 times, 9Sc, (2Sc, INC) repeat 2 times (42)
- 5 row** 3Sc, INC, 9Sc, (3Sc, INC) repeat 3 times, 9Sc, (3Sc, INC) repeat 2 times (48)
- 6 row** Sc in each Sc around (48)
- 7 row** 10Sc, connect sand yarn and cut light pink one, all next stitches of that row **must be crocheted back loops only** (Image 1) 38Sc (48)
- In the next row (8th) crochet **first 10Sc back loops only.**
- 8 row** BLO10Sc, 38Sc (48)

Tip 3

To avoid uneven edges, all details that are made in spiral technique must be finished with a slip stitch.

3.1 Head

- 9 row** 25Sc, (INC, 1Sc) repeat 9 times, 5Sc (57)
10 row 26Sc, INC, 5Sc, INC, 10Sc, INC, 5Sc, INC, 7Sc (61)

Place the eyes between the 10th and 11th rows. The distance between the eyes should be 18 stitches (Image 3).

- 11 row** Sc in each Sc around (61)
12 row 31Sc, INC, 4Sc, INC, 8Sc, INC, 4Sc, INC, 10Sc (65)
13 row Sc in each Sc around (65)
14 row 32Sc, INC, 5Sc, INC, 8Sc, INC, 5Sc, INC, 11Sc (69)
15 – 23 rows Sc in each Sc around (69)
24 row (21Sc, INVDEC) repeat 3 times (66)
25 row (9Sc, INVDEC) repeat 6 times (60)
26 row 4Sc, INVDEC, (8Sc, INVDEC) repeat 5 times, 4Sc (54)
27 row (7Sc, INVDEC) repeat 6 times (48)
 Stuff detail with stuffing material, continue crocheting.
28 row 3Sc, INVDEC, (6Sc, INVDEC) repeat 5 times, 3Sc (42)
29 row (5Sc, INVDEC) repeat 6 times (36)
30 row 2Sc, INVDEC, (4Sc, INVDEC) repeat 5 times, 2Sc (30)
31 row (3Sc, INVDEC) repeat 6 times (24)
32 row 1Sc, INVDEC, (2Sc, INVDEC) repeat 5 times, 1Sc (18)
33 row (1Sc, INVDEC) repeat 6 times (12)
34 row 6INVDEC (6), Sl

Cut the yarn. Tighten all stitches and hide the end of yarn inside the head.

4. Body

With sand yarn

- 1 row** 6Sc in magic circle (6)
- 2 row** 6INC (12)
- 3 row** (1Sc, INC) repeat 6 times (18)
- 4 row** (2Sc, INC) repeat 6 times (24)
- 5 row** (3Sc, INC) repeat 6 times (30)
- 6 row** (4Sc, INC) repeat 6 times (36)
- 7 row** (5Sc, INC) repeat 6 times (42)
- 8 row** Sc in each Sc around (42)
- 9 row** (6Sc, INC) repeat 6 times (48)
- 10 – 15 rows** Sc in each Sc around (48)
- 16 row** (6Sc, INVDEC) repeat 6 times (42)
- 17 – 18 rows** Sc in each Sc around (42)
- 19 row** 2Sc, INVDEC, (5Sc, INVDEC) repeat 5 times, 3Sc (36)
- 20 – 22 rows** Sc in each Sc around (36)
- 23 row** (4Sc, INVDEC) repeat 6 times (30), Sl

Cut the yarn, leave a long end for sewing.

Stuff detail with stuffing material.

5. Forelegs

With brown yarn

1 row 6Sc in magic circle (6)

2 row 6INC (12)

Connect sand yarn and cut brown one.

3 row FLOSc in each Sc around (12)

4 – 5 rows Sc in each Sc around (12)

Bend the detail a little (*Image 13*).

5.1 Forelegs

For the 6th row, crochet into the stitches of the previous row and the remaining back loops of the 3rd row at the same time (*Image 14*).

6 row Sc in each Sc around (12)

7 – 11 rows Sc in each Sc around (12)

Stuff detail with stuffing material, continue crocheting.

12 row (1Sc, INVDEC) repeat 4 times (8)

13 row (1Sc, INVDEC) repeat 2 times, 2Sc (6), Sl

Cut the yarn, leave a long end for sewing. Guide the yarn into each front loop of the last row using a needle inserted from the outer part of the detail (*Image 18*). Fasten off the hole, do not cut the yarn (*Image 19*).

6. Hind legs

With brown yarn

1 row 7Sc in magic circle (7)

2 row 7INC (14)

Connect sand yarn and cut brown one.

3 row BLO(1Sc, INC) repeat 7 times (21)

4 row FLOSc in each Sc around (21)

5 – 6 rows Sc in each Sc around (21)

Bend the detail a little (*Image 24*).

6.1 Hind legs

For the 7th row, crochet into the stitches of the previous row and the remaining back loops of the 4th row at the same time (*Image 25*).

- 7 row** 14Sc, Ch turn (14)
- 8 row** Sc in third stitch, 10Sc, INVDEC, Ch turn (12)
- 9 row** Sc in third stitch, 8Sc, INVDEC, Ch turn (10)
- 10 row** Sc in third stitch, 6Sc, INVDEC, Ch turn (8)
- 11 row** Sc in third stitch, 4Sc, INVDEC, Ch turn (6)
- 12 row** Sc in third stitch, 2Sc, INVDEC, Ch turn (4)
- 13 row** Sc in third stitch, INVDEC (2)

6.2 Hind legs

14 row Crochet the whole circumference of the detail: 1Sc in the same stitch, e.g. in INVDEC, 7Sc into transverse loops (*Image 28*), 7Sc crochet into the stitches of the 7th row and the remaining back loops of the 4th row at the same time (*Image 29*), 7Sc into transverse loops, 2Sc (24), Sl

Cut the yarn, leave a long end for sewing.

Stuff detail with stuffing material.

Make 2 details.

7. Ears

With sand yarn

- 1 row** 6Sc in magic circle (6)
- 2 row** Sc in each Sc around (6)
- 3 row** 6INC (12)
- 4 row** (3Sc, INC) repeat 3 times (15)
- 5 – 7 rows** Sc in each Sc around (15)
- 8 row** (3Sc, INVDEC) repeat 3 times (12)
- 9 row** Sc in each Sc around (12)
- 10 row** (2Sc, INVDEC) repeat 3 times (9), Sl

Cut the yarn, leave a long end for sewing.

Make 2 details.

Pinch the ear so that the stitches of the last row line each other.

Sew the first and second pair of stitches together to fix the desired shape (*Images 34 and 35*).

Repeat with the second ear.

8. Horns

With milky white yarn

- 1 row 7Sc in magic circle (7)
- 2 row 3Sc, 2INC, 2Sc (9)
- 3 row 4Sc, 2INC, 3Sc (11)
- 4 row Sc in each Sc around (11), Sl

Cut the yarn, leave a long end for sewing.

Stuff detail with stuffing material.

Make 2 details.

9. Udder

With light pink yarn

- 1 row 6Sc in magic circle (6)
- 2 row 6INC (12)
- 3 row (1Sc, 2Dc that you both link together at the end (Images 38 and 39), Ch, INC) repeat 4 times (20)
- 4 row Sc in each Sc around (20), Sl

Cut the yarn, leave a long end for sewing.

9.1 Udder

Connect a long light pink yarn to the back side of the udder (the same yarn that you used before). Guide the end of the yarn to the front side where one of the convexas is situated (2Dc linked together at the end). Make 4 turns around the convex, inserting the needle as shown on the photo (*Images 41 and 42*). Try to fix the yarn so that the next turn do not overlap the previous one. Whirl a final loop around the complete papilla (*Image 43*). Fasten this loop, holding it with a finger and placing it around the base of the papilla (*Image 44*).

10. Tail

With sand yarn

- 1 row 5Sc in magic circle (5)
- 2 – 11 rows Sc in each Sc around (5)
- 12 row INC, 4Sc (6), Sl

Cut the yarn, leave a long end for sewing.

Prepare a few strands of brown yarn. Insert them with a hook through the tail. This will create a loop on the other side. Guide one more piece of yarn to the loop that we made on previous step and make a knot (*Images 46 and 47*). Pull the pieces of yarn back so that the knot moves to the first row of the tail (*Images 48*). Sew the ends of yarn that we used to make a knot to the tail (*Images 49*). Cut the strands to size to give the desired length to the tail (*Image 50*).



11. Clover

With light green yarn

Magic circle


1 row (5Ch, 1Sl into magic circle) repeat 4 times (Image 53).

Fasten off the magic circle by pulling the end of yarn from the beginning of crocheting (Image 54).

2 row Crochet in each arch of 5Ch (Image 55): 1Sl, 1HDc, 1Ch, 1Sc, 1Ch, 1HDc, 1Sl (Image 56).

Cut the yarn, leave a long end for sewing. Fasten the end of yarn (Image 58). **Sew the clover, making its back side face forward.**

Scheme for crocheting the clover



- Ch beginning of crocheting chain
- Ch chain
- × Sc single crochet
- ∨ Sl slip stitch
- ┆ HDc half double crochet

12. Black and white Mia

You can change the color of Mia as you want. To make a black and white-colored cow, just change the color of a few rows of a hind leg to black. One of the ears could be crocheted following the pattern below.

With black yarn

- 1 row 6Sc in magic circle (6)
 - 2 row Sc in each Sc around (6)
 - 3 row 6INC (12)
 - 4 row (3Sc, INC) repeat 3 times (15)
 - 5 – 7 rows Sc in each Sc around (15)
 - 8 row (3Sc, INVDEC) repeat 3 times (12)
- Connect white yarn** and cut black one.
- 9 row (3Sc, Sc spike) repeat 3 times (12)
 - 10 row (2Sc, INVDEC) repeat 3 times (9), Sl

Sc spike is crocheted into the stitch one row below the previous row.

13. Spots

With black yarn

First type

Ch5

- 1 row Sc in second stitch, 3Sc, 2Ch turn (4)
- 2 row Sc in second stitch, 3Sc, 1Ch turn (4)
- 3 row Sc in third stitch, 2Sc, 2Ch turn (3)
- 4 row Sc in second stitch, 3Sc (4)

Cut the yarn, leave a long end for sewing.

Make 2 details.

Ch4

- 1 row Sc in second stitch, 2Sc, 2Ch turn (3)
- 2 row Sc in second stitch, 2Sc (3)

Cut the yarn, leave a long end for sewing.

Make 2 details.

Ch5

- 1 row Sc in second stitch, 3Sc, 2Ch turn (4)
- 2 row Sc in second stitch, 2Sc (3)

Cut the yarn, leave a long end for sewing.

Make 2 details.

14. Assembly

Place the body under the head (nose's color transition place facing below (*Image 65*)) and fasten it with pins.

The front side of the body should be placed 6 rows lower than the color transition on the head (*Image 66*).

Sew the body with the end of yarn that we left before (*Image 67*).

Fasten and cut the yarn, hiding the end inside the body (*Images 68 and 69*).

14.1 Assembly

Place the horns symmetrically on the top of the head so, that the side with increases is facing towards the place where the ears will be situated and fasten them with pins. The front points of the horns should be placed on the 19th row of the head (*Image 70*). The distance between the horns should be 12 stitches (*Image 71*). Sew the horns with the ends of milky white yarn that we left before (*Image 72*). Skip one row downwards from the horns and place the ears (*Image 75*). Sew the ears with the ends of sand yarn that we left before. The horns and the ears should be placed on the same line (*Image 77*). Fasten and cut the yarn, hiding the ends inside the head (*Image 76*).

14.2 Assembly

Place the hind legs symmetrically on the bottom part of the body, orienting them as shown on the photo (*Image 78*) and fasten them with pins.

Sew the hind legs with the ends of sand yarn that we left before (*Image 79*).

Fasten and cut the yarn, hiding the end inside the body (*Images 80 and 81*).

14.3 Assembly

Place the forelegs symmetrically, orienting them as shown on the photo (*Image 82*) and fasten them with pins.

Sew the forelegs along the dotted line that is shown on the photo with the ends of sand yarn that we left before (*Image 83*).

Fasten and cut the yarn, hiding the ends inside the body (*Image 85*).

14.4 Assembly

Place the udder on the front part of the body and fasten it with pins. The udder should be placed 6 rows lower than the place of connection between body and head (*Image 86*). Sew the udder with the end of light pink yarn that we left before (*Image 87*). Fasten and cut the yarn, hiding the end inside the body (*Image 88*).

Place the tail on the bottom part of the body, right at the center and fasten it with pins (*Image 89*). Sew the tail with the end of yellow yarn that we left before (*Images 90 and 91*).

14.5 Assembly

To make Mia look more cute, you can embroider eyelashes near her eyes (*Images 92 and 93*), and a blush under her eyes (*Images 94 and 95*). Place the clover between the ear and horn and sew it with the end of light green yarn that we left before (*Image 96*).

14.6 Assembly

If you're making a black and white Mia, place the spots onto the body, orienting them as shown on the photo (*Images 97 and 98*) and fasten them with pins. Place 3 spots onto the front part of the body in the following way: the lowest spot of second type, the highest spot of first type, and the spot of the third type in the middle (*Image 97*). Place the remaining 3 spots at the back in the following way: the spot of first type is on the bottom, the spot of third type is at the top, and the spot of the second type in the middle (*Image 98*). **You can place the spots as you think fits better in your opinion.**

Embroider Mia's closed eyes with black yarn. The starting points of Mia's eyes should be situated on the 9th row of the head (*Image 99*), and the final points – on the 13th row (*Image 100*). The length of the eye between these points is 6.5 stitches (*Image 101*). The distance between the eyes should be 9 stitches (*Image 102*).
