Crochet pattern by **AradiyaToys**

# 1. Instruments and materials

- 1.00 mm hook
- Milky white, blue and white yarn
- Sewing needle
- Stuffing material
- Pieces of wool in red, orange, yellow, green, blue, navy blue and purple colors



**Unicorn Corki** is a design toy, created specially for “AradiyaToys Design” collection. You are not allowed to sell the toys that are crocheted following this pattern.

This toy was crocheted with “Iris” yarn (150m/25g). This is 100% cotton. To create a toy with a height of 10.5 cm, you must crochet with single yarn, using a 1.00 mm hook. To create the mane and the tail, you need to use merino wool, combed sliver with a 18 mic thickness in rainbow color. The stuffing material used in this toy is polyester wadding.

This pattern is for personal use only. Sharing information from this pattern is prohibited. If you publish photos of the toys that are crocheted following this pattern, it is better to mention the author of the pattern. You can also use hashtag #AradiyaToys at Twitter and Instagram to share your toy and see other toys that are created following AradiyaToys’ patterns.

## 2. Abbreviations

<b>Ch</b>	chain
<b>Sc</b>	single crochet
<b>Dc</b>	double crochet
<b>Tr</b>	treble crochet
<b>HDc</b>	half double crochet
<b>INCHDc</b>	increase with HDc
<b>TrINVDEC</b>	treble invisible decrease
<b>Sl</b>	slip stitch
<b>INC</b>	increase
<b>INVDEC</b>	invisible decrease
<b>BLO</b>	back loops only
<b>FLO</b>	front loops only

### Tip 2

**To keep track of the beginning of the row, use a marker. Pin marker to the last loop of the row. Every new row must be finished with a loop at the marker.**

### Tip 1

**The toy must be crocheted with tight stitches, to be sure that there won't be any holes through which stuffing material can be seen.**

All amigurumi toys are crocheted with tight stitches. Avoid small holes when stretching crochet fabric, if there are some tiny holes, use a smaller size hook. To avoid seams, all details are crocheted in a spiral without slip stitch and lifting loops. There is a chance that you will lose the beginning of the row; to avoid this, use a marker. It can be a colored pin or thread of contrasting color.

## 3. Head

*With milky white yarn*

Ch6

- 1 row** Sc in second stitch, 3Sc, 3Sc in the next stitch (crochet round), 3Sc, 2Sc in the next stitch (that already has the very first single crochet) (12)
- 2 row** INC, 3Sc, 3INC, 3Sc, 2INC (18)
- 3 row** 1Sc, INC, 3Sc, (1Sc, INC) repeat 3 times, 3Sc, (1Sc, INC) repeat 2 times (24)
- 4 row** 2Sc, INC, 3Sc, (2Sc, INC) repeat 3 times, 3Sc, (2Sc, INC) repeat 2 times (30)
- 5 row** 3Sc, INC, 3Sc, (3Sc, INC) repeat 3 times, 3Sc, (3Sc, INC) repeat 2 times (36)
- 6 row** 4Sc, INC, 3Sc, (4Sc, INC) repeat 3 times, 3Sc, (4Sc, INC) repeat 3 times (42)
- 7 – 12 rows** Sc in each Sc around (42)

## Tip 3

**To avoid uneven edges, all details that are made in spiral technique must be finished with a slip stitch.**

## 3.1 Head

- 13 row** 16Sc, INC, 3Sc, (INC, 2Sc) repeat 2 times, INC, 4Sc, (INC, 2Sc) repeat 2 times, INC, 3Sc, INC (50)
- 14 row** Sc in each Sc around (50)
- 15 row** 17Sc, INC, 4Sc, (INC, 3Sc) repeat 2 times, INC, 4Sc, (INC, 3Sc) repeat 2 times, INC, 4Sc, INC, 1Sc (58)
- 16 row** Sc in each Sc around (58)
- 17 row** 33Sc, INC, 6Sc, INC, 17Sc (60)
- 18 row** 34Sc, INC, 6Sc, INC, 18Sc (62)
- 19 – 23 rows** Sc in each Sc around (62)
- 24 row** 35Sc, INVDEC, 6Sc, INVDEC, 17Sc (60)
- 25 row** Sc in each Sc around (60)
- 26 row** (8Sc, INVDEC) repeat 6 times (54)
- 27 row** (7Sc, INVDEC) repeat 6 times (48)  
Stuff detail with stuffing material, continue crocheting.
- 28 row** (6Sc, INVDEC) repeat 6 times (42)
- 29 row** (5Sc, INVDEC) repeat 6 times (36)
- 30 row** (4Sc, INVDEC) repeat 6 times (30)
- 31 row** (3Sc, INVDEC) repeat 6 times (24)
- 32 row** (2Sc, INVDEC) repeat 6 times (18)
- 33 row** (1Sc, INVDEC) repeat 6 times (12)
- 34 row** 6INVDEC (6), SI

Cut the yarn. Tighten all stitches and hide the end of yarn inside the head.

## 4. Body

**With milky white yarn**

- 1 row 6Sc in magic circle (6)
- 2 row 6INC (12)
- 3 row (1Sc, INC) repeat 6 times (18)
- 4 row (2Sc, INC) repeat 6 times (24)
- 5 row (3Sc, INC) repeat 6 times (30)
- 6 row (4Sc, INC) repeat 6 times (36)
- 7 row (5Sc, INC) repeat 6 times (42)
- 8 row Sc in each Sc around (42)
- 9 row (6Sc, INC) repeat 6 times (48)
- 10 – 15 rows Sc in each Sc around (48)
- 16 row (6Sc, INVDEC) repeat 6 times (42)
- 17 – 18 rows Sc in each Sc around (42)
- 19 row (5INVDEC) repeat 6 times (36)
- 20 – 22 rows Sc in each Sc around (36)
- 23 row (4INVDEC) repeat 6 times (30)
- 24 row Sc in each Sc around (30), SI

Cut the yarn, leave a long end for sewing.

Stuff detail with stuffing material.

## 5. Forelegs

**With blue yarn**

1 row 6Sc in magic circle (6)

2 row 6INC (12)

Connect milky white yarn and cut blue one.

3 row FLOSc in each Sc around (12)

4 – 5 rows Sc in each Sc around (12)

Bend the detail a little. (Image 15)

## 5.1 Forelegs

For the 6th row, crochet only the back loops of the stitches of the 3rd row.

**6 row** Sc in each Sc around (12)

**7 – 11 rows** Sc in each Sc around (12)

Stuff detail with stuffing material, continue crocheting.

**12 row** (1Sc, INVDEC) repeat 4 times (8)

**13 row** (1Sc, INVDEC) repeat 2 times, 2Sc (6), Sl

Cut the yarn, leave a long end for sewing.

Make 2 details.

## 6. Hind legs

### **With blue yarn**

**1 row** 7Sc in magic circle (7)

**2 row** 7INC (14)

Connect milky white yarn and cut blue one.

**3 row** BLO(1Sc, INC) repeat 7 times (21)

**4 row** FLOSc in each Sc around (21)

**5 – 6 rows** Sc in each Sc around (21)

Bend the detail a little. (Image 24)

## 6.1 Hind legs

For the 7th row, crochet only the back loops of the stitches of the 4th row.

- 7 row** 14Sc, Ch turn (14)
- 8 row** Sc in third stitch, 10Sc, INVDEC, Ch turn (12)
- 9 row** Sc in third stitch, 8Sc, INVDEC, Ch turn (10)
- 10 row** Sc in third stitch, 6Sc, INVDEC, Ch turn (8)
- 11 row** Sc in third stitch, 4Sc, INVDEC, Ch turn (6)
- 12 row** Sc in third stitch, 2Sc, INVDEC, Ch turn (4)
- 13 row** Sc in third stitch , INVDEC (2)

## 6.2 Hind legs

**14 row** Crochet the whole circumference of the detail: 1Sc (in the same stitch, e.g. in INVDEC), 7Sc (into transverse loops), 7Sc (crochet only the back loops of the stitches of the 4th row), 7Sc (into transverse loops), 2Sc (24), Sl

Cut the yarn, leave a long end for sewing.

Stuff detail with stuffing material.

## 7. Ears

### **With milky white yarn**

- 1 row 5Sc in magic circle (5)
- 2 row 1Sc, INC, 1Sc, INC, 1Sc (7)
- 3 row 2Sc, INC, 2Sc, INC, 1Sc (9)
- 4 row 3Sc, INC, 3Sc, INC, 1Sc (11)
- 5 row 4Sc, INC, 4Sc, INC, 1Sc (13)
- 6 row 4Sc, INVDEC, 4Sc, INVDEC, 1Sc (11)
- 7 row 3Sc, INVDEC, 3Sc, INVDEC, 1Sc, Ch turn (9)
- 8 row Sc in second stitch, 4Sc (5)

Cut the yarn, leave a long end for sewing.

Make 2 details.

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## 7.1 Inner part of the ear

### **With blue yarn**

Ch5

- 1 row Sc in second stitch, 1HDc, 1Dc, 1Tr (4)

Cut the yarn, leave a long end for sewing.

Make 2 details.

Place and sew the inner part of the ear as shown on the photo. (Image 36)

Repeat with the second ear.

## 8. Horn

### **With blue yarn**

- 1 row 4Sc in magic circle (4)
- 2 row (1Sc, INC) repeat 2 times (6)
- 3 row (2Sc, INC) repeat 2 times (8)
- 4 row (3Sc, INC) repeat 2 times (10)
- 5 row Sl in each Sc around (10)
- 6 row FLO(4Sc, INC) repeat 2 times (12)
- 7 row (5Sc, INC) repeat 2 times (14)
- 8 row Sl in each Sc around (14)
- 9 row FLOSc in each Sc around (14)
- 10 row 4Sc, 2HDc, INCHDc, 2HDc, 4Sc, INC (16)
- 11 row Sl in each Sc around (16)

Cut the yarn, leave a long end for sewing.

Stuff detail with stuffing material.

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## 9. Eyelids

### **With milky white yarn**

Ch11

- 1 row Sc in second stitch, 9Sc (10)

Cut the yarn, leave a long end for sewing.

Make 2 details.

# 10. Stomach

**With blue yarn**

Ch10

- 1 row** Sc in second stitch, 8Sc, Ch turn(9)
- 2 row** INC, 7Sc, INC, Ch turn (11)
- 3 row** Sc in each Sc around (11)
- 4 row** INC, 9Sc, INC, Ch turn (13)
- 5 – 8 rows** Sc in each Sc around (13)
- 9 row** INVDEC, 9Sc, INVDEC, Ch turn(11)
- 10 – 11 rows** Sc in each Sc around (11)
- 12 row** INVDEC, 7Sc, INVDEC, Ch turn(9)
- 13 row** INVDEC, 5Sc, INVDEC, Ch turn(7)
- 14 row** INVDEC, 3Sc, INVDEC, Ch turn(5)
- 15 row** 5Sc, Ch turn (5)
- 16 row** 5Sc, crochet the whole circumference of the detail: 41Sc (46), Sl

Cut the yarn, leave a long end for sewing.

# 11. Eyes

**With white yarn**

- 1 row 6Sc in magic circle (6)
- 2 row 6INC (12)
- 3 row (1Sc, INC) repeat 6 times (18)
- 4 – 6 rows Sc in each Sc around (18)
- 7 row (1Sc, INVDEC) repeat 6 times (12)
- 8 row 6INVDEC (6), Sl

Cut the yarn, leave a long end for sewing. There is no need to fill the eyes with stuffing material.

# 12. Wings

Every wing consists of four parts. For more comfortable crocheting I recommend you to crochet two details of fourth, third and second parts, cutting the yarn in the end. Next, crochet one piece of first part, do not cut the yarn, proceed to connection of the wing parts. Only after you have finished one wing, proceed to crocheting the first part of the second wing.

**With white yarn**

Fourth part

- 1 row 5Sc in magic circle (5)
- 2 row 1Sc, INC, 1Sc, INC, 1Sc (7)
- 3 row Sc in each Sc around (7), Sl

Cut the yarn, leave a long end for sewing.

Make 2 details.

# 12.1 Wings

## **With white yarn**

Third part

- 1 row** 5Sc in magic circle (5)
- 2 row** 1Sc, INC, 1Sc, INC, 1Sc (7)
- 3 – 4 rows** Sc in each Sc around (7), Sl

Cut the yarn, leave a long end for sewing.

Make 2 details.

Second part

- 1 row** 6Sc in magic circle (6)
- 2 row** 1Sc, INC, 1Sc, INC, 1Sc, INC (9)
- 3 row** Sc in each Sc around (9)
- 4 row** INC, 8Sc (10)
- 5 row** Sc in each Sc around (10), Sl

Cut the yarn, leave a long end for sewing.

Make 2 details.

- 1 row** 6Sc in magic circle (6)
- 2 row** 1Sc, INC, 1Sc, INC, 1Sc, INC (9)
- 3 row** Sc in each Sc around (9)
- 4 row** INC, 3Sc, INC, 4Sc (11)
- 5 – 6 rows** Sc in each Sc around (11)

Do not cut the yarn.

## 12.2 Connection of wings' parts

**With white yarn**

- 1 row** first part: 5Sc, (Image 48)  
second part: 4Sc, (Images 49 and 50)  
third part: 3Sc, (Images 51 and 52)  
fourth part: 6Sc, (Images 53 and 54)  
(crochet round)  
(skip: 1Sc on the third part) 2Sc, (Image 55)  
(skip: 1Sc on the second part) 4Sc, (Images 56 and 57)  
(skip: 1Sc on the first part) 5Sc (Images 58 and 59) (29)

## 12.3 Connection of wings' parts

- 2 row** 1Sc, INVDEC, 1Sc, INVDEC, 2Sc, INVDEC, 4Sc, INVDEC, 3Sc, INVDEC, 2Sc, INVDEC, 1Sc, INVDEC, 1Sc (22)
- 3 row** 6Sc, INVDEC, 5Sc, INVDEC, 7Sc (20)  
Stuff detail with stuffing material, continue crocheting.
- 4 row** Tr INVDEC, 2Sc, Tr INVDEC, 1Sc, INVDEC, 1Sc, Tr INVDEC, 2Sc, Tr INVDEC (11)
- 5 row** 1Sc, 5INVDEC (6), Sl

Cut the yarn. Tighten all stitches and hide the end of yarn inside the wing.

Make 2 details.

# 13. Assembly

Place the body under the head and fasten it with pins.

Sew it with the end of milky white yarn that we left before.

Fasten and cut the yarn, hiding the end inside the body.

Place the eyes symmetrically on the top part of the head and fasten them with pins.

Sew the eyes, making a seam around the circumference.

Fasten and cut the yarn, hiding the end inside the body.

# 13.1 Assembly

Place the stomach on the front part of the body and fasten it with pins. (Image 69)

Sew the stomach with the end of blue yarn that we left before. Fasten and cut the yarn, hiding the end inside the body. (Image 70)

Place the legs symmetrically on the bottom part of the body and fasten them with pins. (Images 71 and 72)

Sew the legs with the ends of milky white yarn that we left before. Fasten and cut the yarn, hiding the end inside the body. (Images 73 and 74)

## 13.2 Assembly

Place the horn on the forehead, just above the eyes and fasten it with pins. *(Image 75)*  
Sew it with the end of blue yarn. Fasten and cut the yarn, hiding the end inside the head. *(Image 76)*

Place the ears symmetrically on the top of the head and fasten them with pins. *(Image 77)*

The ears should be placed on the same line. *(Image 78)*

Sew the ears with the ends of milky white yarn that we left before. *(Image 79)*

Fasten and cut the yarn, hiding the end inside the head. *(Image 80)*

## 13.3 Assembly

Place the front paws symmetrically and fasten them with pins. *(Image 81)*

Sew the front paws with the ends of milky white yarn that we left before. *(Image 82)*

Fasten and cut the yarns, hiding the ends inside the body. *(Images 83 and 84)*

## 13.4 Assembly

Embroider the nostrils symmetrically on the edges of the nose with blue yarn. (Image 85)

Embroider the nostrils around with a thin strand of gray yarn. (Image 86)

Place the wings symmetrically on the back of the body and fasten them with pins. (Image 87)

Connect thin white yarn and sew the wings to the body. (Image 88)

## 13.5 Assembly

Fasten and cut the yarns, hiding the ends inside the body.  
(Images 90 and 91)

Choose the place for the pupils, connect black yarn and  
embroider them. (Images 92 and 93)

## 13.6 Assembly

Embroider the belly button in spiral on the bottom center of the body with a thin strand of black yarn.

Embroider sparkles at the edge of the pupils with white yarn. Fasten and cut the yarn, hiding the ends inside the head.

Place the eyelids on the top part of the eyes and fasten them with pins.

Sew the eyelids with the ends of milky white yarn that we left before.

Fasten and cut the yarns, hiding the ends inside the head.

# 14. Mane

Take wool in all rainbow colors. Take every color of wool and split them into thin strands. Insert the hook into the stitch to the center of the back bottom part of the head. Take a purple strand and guide it through the stitch. Guide the ends of the strand into the loop and tighten. The first strand of the mane is ready. Insert the hook into the next stitch and do the same with a second strand. Continue until you get 4 strands in the line. (Image 106)

# 14.1 Mane

Skip three rows to the top from the purple strands. In the same way make a line of navy blue wool color. Now proceed to the top part of the head. Skip two rows from the horn and make the next line of red wool color. After this, choose a place for other four colors of the rainbow evenly. (Image 110) Fill the remaining space without wool with a corresponding color of the wool. (Image 111) Curl the strands of all colors. (Image 112) Cut extra wool to make the mane shorter on the edges (purple and red colors) than in the middle (green color).

## 15. Tail

Prepare one thin strand of each color for the tail. Insert the hook through two stitches on the back bottom part of the body and take a strand of red color. Guide this strand so that ends should be on both sides of the stitch. Guide all colors of the wool into this stitch one by one. (Images 116 and 117) Connect and comb out the strands of the tail.



# 15.1 Tail

Wet your hands and curl the ends of the wool on the tail and mane. (Image 120)

Let them dry in this state. Cut the end of curled wool on the tail, leaving nearly two centimeters. (Image 121)

Put the end of the wool inside the tail. (Images 122 and 123)

Cut the dry ends on the mane. (Image 124)
